
Operating System Requirements

Precision Loggers desktop software requires an ARM64 installation of macOS 12 (“Monterey”) or higher. The easiest way to check your computer’s operating system version is as follows:

1. Click on the Apple (🍏) icon in the upper left corner of your display.
2. Click **About This Mac**.
3. Under the **macOS** entry, read the version number. The number to the left of the decimal point is known as the *major version*, and the number to the right of the decimal point is known as the *minor version*. If the major version is greater than or equal to 12, your operating system is compatible with Precision Loggers software.
4. If the words “Intel Core” show up under the **Chip** entry, your processor is not compatible with our software, which is compiled for ARM64 architecture.



Launching The Installer

Once you have downloaded the *Precision Loggers Installer* from <https://precisionloggers.com>, open a new Finder window and navigate to the Downloads directory. Double click to start the installer package.



Installation Process


With the installer opened, read each page, then click on continue. You must agree to the terms and conditions of the license agreement in order to install Precision Loggers. You can cancel the installation process at any time.




When you click on **Install**, you will be required to enter your password. This is a security measure Apple requires to prevent unwanted processes from modifying your system.



When the installation is complete, click **Close** to exit the installer.




You may be asked if you would like to remove the installer package file. We recommend removing it. Updates and new releases will be available at our website, so you won't need to store your current version's installer.



Launch Precision Loggers

In the *Dock* at the bottom of the display, click on **Launchpad**. From there, launch the newly installed Precision Loggers application. You can also find it in the root **Applications** directory in Finder.

This guide only covers the installation of Precision Loggers, but not its usage. Once Precision Loggers is open, click on the Help menu and select User Manual.
